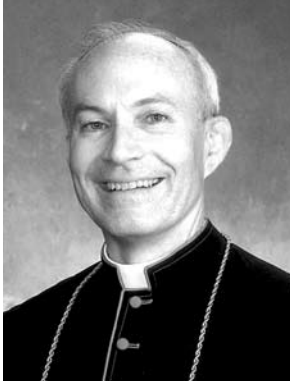

**MOST REV. GEORGE LUCAS** was born in St. Louis, MO and was ordained to the priesthood there in 1975.

He has served as a parish priest, high school teacher and as Chancellor and Vicar General of the Archdiocese of St. Louis. He has also served as rector of Kenrick-Glennon Seminary. He was ordained and installed as eighth bishop of the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois in December 1999. Bishop Lucas first accompanied a group of pilgrims to the Holy Land in 2005.

**SUE AND JIM MORRIS** are from the Springfield Diocese where they are known as "tireless ministers of prayer, justice and peace."

Jim and Sue co-founded Koinonia, a spiritual weekend for adults now thriving in 24 states and 2 countries. In 1991 they were awarded the Spiritus Franciscanus award by Joliet's University of St. Francis. They were instrumental in developing RCIA programs at 3 parishes and in bringing Teens Encounter Christ and Pax Christi to Springfield. They also led Habitat for Humanity in Springfield for two years. Together they have organized and directed hundreds of individual and group retreats. Sue worked almost eleven years for the Diocese of Springfield, concentrating her efforts in spirituality along with peace and justice issues. She is now connecting spirituality with justice through "Salt & Light" offering retreats, presentations and days of prayer. Jim is DRE for Little Flower Parish.

# An Invitation to Join Us

Dear Friends:

Welcome to a Pilgrimage of Peace to the Holy Land.

Pope John Paul II of blessed memory encouraged "pilgrimages of peace" to the Holy Land to express solidarity with the local Christian community. In his address to the general assembly of the Italian bishops' conference, the Pope applauded the initiative adopted by Italian dioceses to promote "pilgrimages of peace to the Holy Land." These pilgrimages are a sign of solidarity, a witness to peace, and an opportunity for economic support of the beleaguered Palestinian Christian community.

Co-sponsored by Catholic Relief Services and the Joliet Diocese Peace and Social Justice Ministry along with Koinonia Retreats, this pilgrimage responds to the Pope's call and the example of the Italian bishops to find solidarity with the people of the Holy Land. Our pilgrimage will include visits to the Holy Places, the "Ancient Stones," important to the People of God. We will walk where Jesus walked. Each day will be steeped in scripture reflections, prayer times, and liturgy. We will also have an opportunity to hear from the oppressed of the land, to witness efforts to bring justice and peace through development and empowerment, to learn from peacemakers and Middle-east issue experts. This will not be a tourist trip, but a pilgrimage. It will be a pilgrimage of prayer, solidarity, and the quest for peace.

## Our Daily Itinerary

**MON, DEC 1, DAY 1: DEPART USA:** We depart Chicago for Tel Aviv, Israel with complimentary meals and beverages served aloft.

**TUES, DEC 2, DAY 2: ARRIVE TEL AVIV / NAZARETH:** Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we are met by our Catholic Travel Center representative and escorted by bus north into the Galilee region to Nazareth. Next we settle into our accommodations in Nazareth, followed by dinner and an orientation. Looking forward to the coming days, some might choose to conclude the day gazing into the night sky, pondering how Jesus, too, might have spent many childhood nights counting these same stars. (D)

**WED, DEC 3, DAY 3: NAZARETH: VISIT OF THE CITY:** We begin the day with a visit to the Church of St. Gabriel and Mary's well. Afterward we visit the synagogue where Jesus began his ministry. His inaugural address, found in Luke chapter four, will focus our journey. After a visit to St. Joseph's Church, we will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation. We meet with Palestinian Christian peacemaker Fr. Fouad Dagher at his church and visit the school. Then we will have lunch with Fr. Fouad at Shefa Amer. After lunch we meet with Archbishop Elias Chakour at Ibillin. This evening we have dinner at our accommodations and meet with Fr. Eli. For those who want, we end our day by praying the rosary together. (B, L, D)

**THU, DEC 4, DAY 4: NAZARETH / MT. TABOR & SEPPHORIS / TIBERIAS:** We begin this day with a visit to the ruins of Sepphoris, a major town during Jesus' day, which is only 3 miles from Nazareth. We will visit Mt. Tabor where Jesus was transfigured while he was in prayer with Peter, James and John. Before leaving we will celebrate Mass. Lunch will be taken at a local restaurant in Nazareth. During the afternoon, before

we depart for Tiberias, we visit the excavation of a street of Nazareth from the 1st century under the Sisters' of Nazareth Convent. We visit Mugableh Church and meet with Fr. Alfonso. We will enjoy our evening meal at our accommodations on the Mount of Beatitudes. We will end the day with reflection and prayer. (B, L, D)

**FRI, DEC 5, DAY 5: TIBERIAS: EXCURSION TO MOUNT OF BEATITUDES & THE SEA OF GALILEE:** We begin our reflective morning by going to the Mount of Beatitudes where we consider the Kingdom of God. We join together for a silent walk down the Mount to the shore of the Sea of Galilee. After some reflection and sharing, we board the "Jesus Boat" for a peaceful journey across the Sea of Galilee. Lunch today will be at a Kibbutz. After lunch we then make our way around the shore to Capernaum where Jesus spent 2 ½ years of his life. We celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Peter's Primacy. Before ending the day we visit Tabgha and the shore of the sea. Dinner is served at our accommodations. After dinner there will be an orientation to our coming days in Jerusalem and reflection on our day. (B, L, D)

**SAT, DEC 6, DAY 6: TIBERIAS / JORDAN RIVER: BAPTISMAL VOWS RENEWAL / JERUSALEM:** We make our way to the Jordan River. Wading into the waters, we renew our baptismal vows. The Holy Spirit upon us, we travel south through the wilderness to the Mount of Temptation. We fast in spirit only, though, for lunch is waiting for us at Al-Rawdah Restaurant in Jericho. After lunch we meet with members from the Palestinian Authority. After a visit to the local pottery shop we head into the Wilderness where we will celebrate Mass. We continue our journey up to Jerusalem where we make our home inside the walls of the Old City. Before dinner we meet with represen-

tatives from the Jerusalem office of Catholic Relief Services which will include a Muslim and Christian staff member. We share our evening meal together. (B, L, D)

**SUN, DEC 7, DAY 7: JERUSALEM: MT. OF OLIVES, GETHSEMANE AND THE HOLY SEPULCHRE:** This day we begin on the Mt. of Olives where we take in the panoramic views of Jerusalem. We visit Bethpage, the traditional starting point of the Palm Sunday procession and follow the path that Jesus took that day. At Dominus Flavit we remember where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Before leaving here we celebrate Mass as we pray for the peace of Jerusalem. Before lunch we visit the school at the East Jerusalem YMCA to see their school program for 3-5 year old Jewish and Palestinian children. We visit the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. Next is an orientation at the Holy Sepulchre. Before dinner at our accommodations we meet with Jewish peacemaker Rabbi David Rosen. (B, L, D)

**MON, DEC 8, DAY 8: JERUSALEM: BETHLEHEM EXCURSION & WAILING WALL:** We begin the day shopping at a local Palestinian shop in Bethlehem. After Mass at Shepherd's Field we stop for a prayerful visit at the Church of the Nativity. We take lunch at Bethlehem University where we will interact with Palestinian students and professors. We hear their stories of pain and their dreams of hope. We visit the Wailing Wall, then return to our accommodations for dinner. We will meet with a local Christian Palestinian family to hear of life for them as Christians living in the Holy Land. (B, L, D)

**TUES, DEC 9, DAY 9: JERUSALEM: LATIN PATRIARCH & CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES:** Dawn's first light finds us celebrating Mass at Christianity's holiest site, the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre inside the Empty Tomb of Jesus Christ. After breakfast this morning we will meet with the Latin Patriarch. We will be hosted by the staff of Catholic Relief Services of Jerusalem and visit the projects in the West Bank. We immerse ourselves in the realities of their life and witness their efforts for peace, justice and development. We will then enjoy lunch in their company. Prior to dinner we will meet with members of the Christian Peacemaking Team. We will end the day with reflection and prayer. (B, L, D)

**WED, DEC 10, DAY 10: JERUSALEM: CHURCH OF ST. ANNE, CHURCH OF ST. PETER IN GALLICANCTU, THE UPPER ROOM:** We begin the day with a visit to Temple Mount. After a visit to St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda we walk the Way of the Cross ending with our visit to Calvary and the tomb. Lunch is at a local restaurant. We will have an afternoon of reflection at the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Christ; we reflect upon our own faithfulness and pray for grace to fulfill the new commitments we have made to Christ during this pilgrimage. We celebrate Mass at the Cenacle Church and commemorate Pentecost. Dinner is served at our accommodations. (B, L, D)

**THU, DEC 11, DAY 11: JERUSALEM: EMMAUS AND TAIBEH:** Breakfast is at our accommodations. During the day there will be time for packing and shopping. We will visit the village of Taibeh, have some time to meet with a local community, and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. We then continue to Emmaus for a visit of the town. Our evening meal will be at Pasha's, a local Palestinian restaurant. (B, L, D)

**FRI, DEC 12H, DAY 12: RETURN USA:** We depart Israel for our return to the United States. (B)

*Note: While no changes are anticipated, there may be unforeseen occasions when certain alterations become necessary to this itinerary, either due to changes in airline schedules or for other reasons. All Masses are subject to local church schedules and substitution with alternate Mass sites if churches mentioned are not available.*

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

## Terms and Conditions

Making any payments (cash, credit card, or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this tour brochure. Catholic Travel Centre shall be referred to as CTC within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

**TRAVEL WARNING:** This is to inform you that there is a Travel Warning issued by the Department of State for travel to Israel, the West Bank and Gaza. This warning might still be in effect on the day of your travel and your cancellation for this reason does not constitute grounds for refund of the cancellation fees listed below.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSITS:** Deposit of \$300 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. No registrations can be taken by telephone. Registrations are processed in the order received by CTC. Balance of payment is due 75 days prior to departure. Late payment is subject to \$50 penalty. Late registration (fewer than 75 days) must be accompanied by full payment by cashiers check only (including the optional passenger travel protection program payment, if applicable), is subject to availability and subject to a \$50 late fee. CTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid in full 60 days prior to departure and to apply the applicable cancellation fees/penalties indicated below. A \$25 fee will be charged on all checks returned by our bank.

**INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS:** Upon cancellation of participation in the tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after CTC receives your signed cancellation in writing sent via certified mail or fax, CTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$100 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure day;
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$200;
- 3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$300 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/or penalties assessed by airlines, hotels, or other suppliers of travel services (up to the total cost of the tour);
- 4) From 7 days prior to departure day and onward, no refund is possible.

The above cancellation fees and/or penalties will also apply if you register for an optional extension or airline routing, and you decide to cancel or change any of these. We highly recommend the Passenger Travel Protection Program (see 'PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM' below.)

**TOUR OPERATION & CANCELLATION:** While no changes are anticipated, CTC expressly reserves the right to cancel all or any part of the tour or to make any changes to the itinerary, for any reason and whenever it deems it necessary for the comfort, convenience or safety of the tour participants. In the event of alterations to the itinerary of the tour, the price shall be adjusted accordingly and any refunds will be issued within two weeks of such alteration. Similarly, any additional monies due CTC shall become payable within two weeks of such alteration. If a tour is cancelled in its entirety, full refunds shall be issued within two weeks of such cancellation. This will constitute, in full, CTC's obligation to tour registrants and CTC bears no further responsibility beyond the full refund. CTC shall not be held liable and hereby expressly disclaims liability for any loss, expense, damage or inconvenience caused as a result of any tour cancellation or changes made to the itinerary.
