On Friday, November 6th workers at the Bissell warehouse in Elwood, IL arrived at work only to be informed they were all fired. Their crime? They had filed complaints against their employer, Roadlink/ Maersk Distribution/Bissell for violating state and federal labor laws.

They have faced a year of disrespect, discrimination of pregnant women, threats of retaliation from management for filing charges and some workers even made LESS than minimum wage.

We are coming together to tell Bissell that this community will not support a company that treats people like trash. Tell them to put people back to work and to follow the law.
