Her background also includes teaching high school and consulting for the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS) creating an extensive resource on global solidarity.

Sr. Katherine has a Masters of Arts degree in Theology from Boston College combining joint studies of Catholic Social Teaching and Economics.
