This workshop day focuses on the foundations for engaging youth in catholic social teaching and describes four strategies to help you infuse justice and service throughout your entire youth ministry.

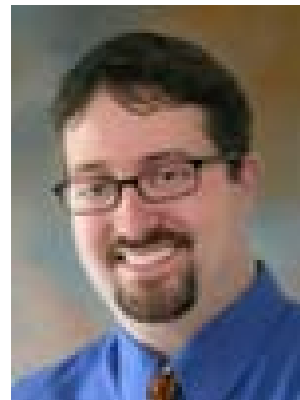
